

AOA Requirements

In order to stay off probation and/or move up in division the following requirements must be submitted each year. You must be off of probation before you are eligible for promotion.

- ✓ **NFHS Interscholastic Officiating Course**---to be completed by **FIRST YEAR MEMBERS ONLY.** You will be emailed information on how to login and view this course on the NFHS Learn website.
- ✓ **Clinic/Rules Meeting**---**RULES MEETINGS MUST BE VIEWED PRIOR TO STATE FINALS IN THE SPORT FOR WHICH YOU ARE REGISTERED. THEY WILL NO LONGER BE AVAILABLE AFTER STATE FINALS.**
 - ☞ Division 1 officials attend AOA clinic every other year and complete AAA online rules meeting* (online) on non-clinic years.
 - ☞ Division 2 and 3 officials attend AOA clinic every year.
 - ☞ **TRACK OFFICIALS:** Track clinic is required for all division officials and is held every other year. Track online rules meeting is required for all officials every year.
- ✓ **Return test with a passing grade every year:**
 - ☞ Division 1 90%
 - ☞ Division 2 80%
 - ☞ Division 3 70%
- ✓ **Return Game Report every year:**

➤ You **must** officiate the required number of games at **each division level**. Example: if you are a football official, you must officiate the equivalent of 15 senior varsity games before being promoted to a D2. As a D2, you must officiate an **additional** (or the equivalent of) 18 senior varsity games before you are eligible for promotion to a D1.

- ✓ **Attend Spring Business Meeting for your District. Each district has a meeting every other year.**
