

Extra-Inning Tie Breaking Procedure

While using the tie-breaker, each half-inning shall begin by placing a runner on second base. That runner shall be the player in the batting order who precedes the leadoff batter in that inning. The game shall then proceed a full inning until a winner is determined in that inning.

This procedure shall be used in games that are tied after seven innings of a single game or five innings of a doubleheader.

Run Rule Procedure

A game is ended when one team is ahead by 15 runs after three innings or 10 runs after five innings.
