Board of Directors may serve up to three elected three-year terms. Only administrators, Superintendents, Assistant Superintendents, Principals or Assistant Principals are eligible to run or vote. **The Superintendent must designate a voting representative in writing.**

Candidates for a position on the AAA Board of Directors must notify the AAA office and their Activity District President at least two (2) weeks prior to the Activity District meeting where their election will be held of their intention to seek election.

Positions Open:

District 2 – Position currently held by Scott Embrey of Beebe. Mr. Embrey has served his first three-year term. Mr. Embrey is eligible for re-election and has declared for the position.

District 3 – Position currently held by Bryan Russell of Valley View. Mr. Russell has served two years of Mr. Gary Williams first term. Mr. Russell is eligible to be elected to his first three-year term and has declared for the position.

District 4 – Position currently held by Gregg Grant of Danville. Mr. Grant has served the final year of Mr. Jim Loyd's final term. Mr. Grant is eligible to be elected to his first three-year term and has declared for the position.

District 5 – Position currently held by Rick McLaughlin of Lakeside. Mr. McLaughlin has served three three-year terms. Mr. McLaughlin is not eligible for re-election.

District 7 – Position currently held by Gary Hines of Emerson-Taylor-Bradley. Mr. Hines has served two three-year terms. Mr. Hines is eligible to be elected to his third three-year term and has declared for the position.
