The AAA Tiebreaker system will be used for all ties.

Teams would be placed on rotating bracket that is enclosed. Schools must play against all schools assigned to their conference to compete for a conference championship and to qualify for the state tournament.

**STATE BASEBALL/SOFTBALL FIELD REQUIREMENTS**

With Class 7A and 4A playing four games per day during the first two rounds in the state baseball and softball tournament, the host school will have the option of using one or two fields throughout the tournament. A secondary field should be available for rescheduling purposes in case of inclement weather.

All other classes will have the option of using a second field following the completion of the first round of the tournament. The host school will be allowed to play the second round and subsequent rounds of the tournament on one field. A secondary field should be available for rescheduling purposes in case of inclement weather.

Once a decision has been made on the number of fields to be used during the tournament, game times and locations will be changed only in the event of inclement weather and with approval of participating schools and the AAA.
