**6. Flextime (January 2012)**

Flextime is a scheduling arrangement that permits variations in an employee's starting and departure times but does not change the total number of hours worked in a week. The Executive Director may permit flex time for support staff in anticipation of a support staff member needing to work outside normal office hours. Flextime will be earned at the rate of one hour off for one hour worked. Flextime shall be used in the same week it is earned so the support staff member does not work more than 40 hours per week.

It is recognized that the administrative staff spend many hours attending activity events that are over and beyond the working days. Although it is not the intent of the association to provide flextime for this type of duty, the Executive Director may permit the administrator to be absent on occasions for an afternoon or portion thereof.
