

3A Boys State Golf Coaches,

On behalf of Fountain Lake High School, I would like thank you for the opportunity to host the Boys 3A State Tournament.

My name is Doug Rountree and I will be the tournament Director. We will have a coaches meeting at 7:45a.m. the morning of the Tournament just outside the pro shop. You may reach me anytime by calling my cell number at 501-282-0041 or email drountree@flcobras.com, if you have any questions about the tournament.

- The Tournament will be held at 9:00 a.m., at DeGray State Golf Course, Arkadelphia, Monday, October 3rd, with a shotgun start at 9:00 a.m. sharp.
- **PROPER DRESS IS MANDATORY! All players must wear collared shirts. No Denim jeans or cutoffs allowed. Softspikes or Tennis shoes only. Proper dress is required for both practice round and the tournament.**
- **The host Golf Manager will be John Stewart. # 501-865-5831.**
- The tournament will be 18 holes of competition. Play four and count 3 for the team title.
- **A 10 stroke limit per hole will be enforced for District and State Tournaments.**
- A practice round is optional. Please contact John Stewart (ask for John) at the Golf shop at DeGray as soon as possible for a practice round tee time. Times are available for 10-1 and 10-2 anytime both days. Greens fees for Players and the Golf Coach are waived, but you will be required to rent a cart for the practice rounds to help with the speed of play. You will have to pay to ride in carts and for range ball for practice. Private carts can be used for practice and on the tournament day for a trail fee of \$5.00. Range balls will be provided for free on the day of the tournament
- DeGray Lodge will be offering discount rates if you tell them you are there for the State Tournament. Call 501-865-5851 or 800-737-8355
- I will need your entries into the tournament no later than Friday, Sept. 23rd. They can be emailed, or called in to me. My email address is drountree@flcobras.com. FAX # is 501-624-4053
- The awards will be handed out immediately following the completion of play and the scores have been verified.
- Please assist your players in learning and abiding by the RULES OF GOLF.
- No caddies may be used; AAA
- Galleries are not allowed in the fairways. They must stay on the cart paths and keep up with their groups. Carts can be rented by spectators on a first come first serve basis. Again, private carts will be allowed at the tournament for a trail fee of \$5.00.
- Electronic range finders are allowed; AAA.
- Monitors/scorers are required for all groups at conference and state tournaments. The role of the monitor/scorer is to verify participants score after each hole and contact course professional and/or tournament director regarding problems or rules interpretations. The host school shall provide each monitor/scorer with an armband, badge, or other type of identifying device. Monitors will be provided by DeGray.
- Boys will play from the white tees.

I realize this is a lot of information concerning our State Tournament, but please read through this several times to insure that there are no questions. If you do have questions, please call at once.
